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Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Between

NASSCOM Foundation

and

M.S. Bidve Engineering College

FOR THE DIGITAL LABS TO SUPPORT MARIGINALISED YOUTH IN SEMI URBAN AND RURAL COLLEGES PROGRAM

This Memorandum of Understanding is made at Delhi on 16th March 2023.

BETWEEN

NASSCOM Foundation, a charitable trust registered under the Indian Trust Act, 1882 vide registration number: 10479, Permanent Account Number AAATN4866D and having its registere d office at A1-125, Lower Ground Floor, Safdarjung Enclave, New Delhi 110021, hereinafter referred to as "NF" (which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors, administrators, executors and assignees) of the First Part.

AND

M.S. Bidve Engineering College located at Latur, Maharashtru (India) hereinafter referred to as "M.S. Bidve Engineering College" or "the College" (which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors and assignees) of the Second Part,

NF and M.S. Bidve Engineering College are collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party".

WHEREAS, NASSCOM Foundation has agreed to partner with M.S. Bidve Engineering College, for the setting up of digital labs under the DIGITAL LABS TO SUPPORT MARIGINALISED YOUTH IN SEMI URBAN AND RURAL COLLEGES PROGRAM ("Program").

AND WHEREAS the Program is a CSR funded program for Creating sustainable skill building plans to support students from murginalised communities under Adobe's CSR Mandate and implemented by the NASSCOM Foundation.

NOW IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. The College Responsibilities:

- 1.1. Shall nominate /Identify Director/ HoD, as the SPOC, with adequate accountability and responsibility to be the executive face of the Program in the college. This person must attend regular review calls at a mutually agreed frequency with NF for updates and assessments of the Project. This person shall ideally be a member of the college faculty.
- 1.2. The College Coordinate will be responsible for the following activities of the Project:
 - Installation and commissioning of the digital lab by 24th March, 2023.
 - Impact Reporting Collecting & Uploading info needed like footfall, photos, milestones, outreach etc.
 - Keyholding Responsible for keeping the digital lab open and accessible

1.3. Shall support with publicity of the Program through the college website.

- 1.4. Shall encourage the Program in a manner so that students will take part in the program on a voluntary basis with fiexible timings.
- 1.5. Shall make available the infrastructure and value added services (including IT infrastructure, applications and connectivity) required to run the Program on its own cost.
- 1.6. Shall provide all the support services and facilities to NF and it partners for the said Program.
- 1.7. Shall coordinate with NF and its Partners and facilitate the conduct of events and other engagement programs as per shared plan.



- 1.8. The college is capable of entering into this Memorandum of Understanding and has all the required permissions for the same. 1.9. Assets Ownership:

The assets provided under the Program shall belong to NASSCOM Foundation and shall be moved out of the College, if NASSCOM Foundation decides to discontinue its engagement with the college in the Program. Subject to any other terms and conditions laid down by NASSCOM Foundation, the College can continue to use the assets if:

- it agrees to sustain the Program without any funding support from NASSCOM
- it agrees to maintain the brand name of the program as provided by NASSCOM Foundations separately in writing:
- It agrees to allow students access to the digital labs for ideation, learning and other
- it agrees to opportunities to learn from NASSCOM Foundation's skilling and volunteering Initiatives
- it agrees to create sustainable skill building plans to support students from marginalised communities
- it agrees to facilitate the participation of students in events organized by NASSCOM Foundation and Adobe;

The peribrmance of college on the above points will be monitored by NASSCOM Foundation regularly. The Program will be allowed to continue only on satisfactory assessment of the performance of College on the above points by NASSCOM Foundation. Decision of NASSCOM in this regard shall be final and binding.

2. NF Responsibilities:

2.1. Will supply the equipment for Digital lab

(List of the equipment attached as announce 1).

- 2.2. Will keep the college informed of any changes in the program plan;
- 2.3. NF shall have no liability qua the equipment after the same have been supplied to the College.

3. Other Terms & Conditions for Engagement

The following are other terms and conditions of engagement:

3.1. Terms of engagement: This MoU is valid from date of execution to 31st March 2023, however both parties agree that based on matual agreement, the terms may be extended. Both parties also agree that terms may be renegotiated.



- 3.2. Training Fees: The College, NF and Partners will not charge any amount on whatsoever account/name from the students in relation to the Program
- 3.3. Limitations and Warranties: Both parties agree that it would be their endeavour to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MoU terms by the other party.
- 3.4. Termination: In case any party to this MoU commit any breach of the terms and conditions of this MoU or violates any statutory provisions or any Government or statutory guidelines or any guidelines issued by the controlling authority, then, in addition to any other remedy available as per law, the other party shall have the right to terminate this agreement by serving at least 15 days' written notice to the defaulting party. However, on such termination, both the parties shall continue to be liable to each other for completion of their mutual rights and obligations under this MoU, which were there on the date of the termination of this MoU.

Both parties to the MoU reserve the right to terminate the MoU with one-month prior notice if in their opinion the Program is not being implemented as per the MoU or the specific aims.

- 3.5. Branding: Both parties shall not use the name and brand of other party or even that of Adobe in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the respective party whose name is intended to be used in any advertisement or branding.
- 3.6. Operational Responsibilities:

The Digital Lab maintenance and operations will be managed by the College.

4. General terms

- 4.1. Indemnification: Both parties agree to indemnify each other and hold the other party harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent, and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees, as related to the terms of this MoU.
- 4.2. Any claim, compensation, case initiated by any student against NASSCOM Foundation/ Adobe in relation to the Program due to any acts or omissions of College shall be defended and contested by the College at their sole expenses and cost keeping NASSCOM Foundation / Adobe indemnified from the same.
- 5.3 Waiver: The rights and remedies provided to each of the Parties herein shall be cumulative and in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law or otherwise. Any failure in the exercise by either Party of its right to terminate this MOU or to enforce any provision of this MOU for default or violation by the other party shall not prejudice such party's rights of termination or enforcement for any further or other's default or violation or be deemed a waiver or forfeiture of those rights.
- 5.4 Severability: If any section or paragraph, or part thereof, of this MOU or any document appended hereto or made a part hereof is rendered invalid, ruled illegal by any court of competent jurisdiction, or unembreeable under present or future laws effective during the term of this MOU.



then it is the intention of the Parties that the remainder of the MOU, or any document appended hereto or made a part hereof, shall not be affected thereby unless the deletion of such provision shall cause this MOU to become materially adverse to any Party in which case the Parties shall negotiate in good faith such changes to the MOU, or enter into suitable amendatory or supplementary MOUs, as will best preserve for the Parties the benefits and obligations under such provision.

- 5.5 Amendment of MOU: The terms and conditions contained in this MOU may be amended or modified only with the mutual consent in writing of both Parties.
- 5.6 Relationship: The relationship between the Parties is that of principal to principal. Nothing in this MOU shall be taken as constituting a Party an employee or agent of the other Party. The Parties undertake that none of their respective employees and staff shall be construed in any manner, either expressly or by implication, as the employees or agents of the other Party and the other Party shall not be liable in any manner whatsoever for any claims, demands and the like made by them.

5.7 Limitation of Liability:

Except for the indemnification obligations, both parties agree that the liability would be limited to the amount of actual transactions between the two parties

6. Intellectual Property Rights

6.1 Neither Party shall be entitled to use the trademarks, logos or any intellectual property belonging to the other Party and its affiliates in any manner without prior written approval from the other Party. The ownership of all proprietary rights in relation to ideas / products developed created, in the maker labs will lie with the creator/creators of the said property.

7 Notices:

7.1 Any notices under this MOU will be sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, to the respective address of Parties as contained in this MOU. Such notice will be effective upon its mailing as specified.

8 Force Majeure:

- 8.1 Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.
- 8.2 Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority, paralemic, epidemic. Provided bowever, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party.



of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.

9. Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

This MoU shall be governed by the laws of India and the parties to this MoU hereby agree that the Courts at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try any dispute or difference arising between the parties out of this MoU and the parties further agree that no other Courts shall have jurisdiction to decide any dispute between the parties, arising out of this MoU.

PREAMBLE:

1. FIELD OF COOPERATION

Both the institutions shall evolve a mutually acceptable schedule to conduct / organize the meets to have the benefits of the stake holders.

WHEREAS:



- Sponsoring eligible employees of COMPANY for doing M.Tech. degrees in MSBECL. The eligibility criteria for selection will be as per norms of MSBECL.
- c. Sponsoring projects, which may be carried out wholly at MSBECL or at premises of COMPANY or partly at MSBECL and partly at COMPANY.
- d. Training of COMPANY personnel through Continuing Education Programmes conducted by MSBECL in areas of interest to COMPANY.
- e. Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between MEBECL and COMPANY.
- Each of the above modes of interaction will be initiated by entering into a separate agreement between the two parties.

3. CONFIDENTIALITY

a. During and for a period of three years from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.

- The obligations above shall not extend to any confidential information for which the receiving party can prove that this information:
- is in the public domain at the time of disclosure or comes within the public domain without fault of the receiving party.
- is already known or become known to the receiving party
- is received from a third party having no obligations of confidentiality to the disclosing party,
- is independently developed by the receiving party; oris required to be disclosed by law or court order.

4. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, when entering into a particular research agreement, the participants may agree to limit each party's right to collaborate with others on that subject.

5. TERMS AND TERMINATION

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, shall expire 3 years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MOU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party. However, no such early termination of this MOU, whether mutual or unilateral, shall affect the obligations of the participants under any Research Agreement, Confidentiality clause as referenced in clause 6 above, or any other agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU, which obligations shall survive any such termination.

6. RELATIONSHIP

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make either party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

6. ASSIGNMENT

It is understood by the Parties herein this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

8. COSTS OF THE MOU

Each Party shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU.

9. SIGNED IN DUPLICATE

This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version of the Agreement and having equal legal validity.

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between M.S. Bidve Engineering College, Latur and Tata Technologies Limited Date: January 17, 2016



M.S. Bidve Engineering College, Latur, (hereinafter referred to as BEC), is a college of Engineering and Technology, having its campus at M.S. Bidve Engineering College Vaswadi, Barshi Road, Po.Box. 112, Latur

And

Tata Technologies Limited (hereinafter referred to as "Tata Technologies") is a company registered under the Indian Companies Act, 1956 and has among other businesses, in the business of providing products and services to OEM and Engineering Sectors in the area of Automotive and Aerospace, having its registered office at 25, Rajiv Gandhi Infotech Park, Pune – 411 057

In the course of this MOU both parties to the MOU mentioned above have been individually referred to as "Party" and jointly as "Parties".

Objective and Terms

- 1. Tata Technologies under segia of the Corporate Sustainability Program (CSP) has identified the need for imparting quality training in the "Design Engineering" domain to 3rd and 4th year Mechanical Engineering Students of BEC. The main intent behind this initiative is to better equip young engineers to increase awareness and industry connect. The Parties intend to enter in to this MOU to provide a frame work evaluating the area of collaboration between them and establish certain rights and obligations between the Parties during such evaluation. Tata Technologies plans to roll out this e-learning program as a pilot project in BEC.
- 2. This MOU further establishes an understanding between the Parties to do a pilot test for conducting a Design Engineering training for 3rd & 4th year Mechanical Engineering students ("Students") of BEC using methods and aids generally associated with distance learning. This training is being planned for the first time by Tata Technologies and is currently being conceptualised by Tata Technologies' employees who are experienced in Design Engineering. This program is being planned as part of the Tata Technologies very successful "Ready Engineer Program" under the asign of its Corporate Sustainability. The program for purposes of this agreement will be referred to a "Distance Ready Engineer" or "DRE" hereinafter.
- DRE is a voluntary initiative and Tata Technologies will design a course for the entire training. Tata
 Technologies' experts and experienced Design Engineering specialists will create an elearning module
 hosted on iGET IT or a platform (as decided by Tata Technologies at that point of time) which will be licensed
 for use to selected engineering students of SEC.

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- 4. The proposed methodology for the program will be decided by Tata Technologies in due course of time in consultation with its own consultants and BEC. The terms and conditions of the license to use the program will be provided by Tata Technologies in due course as may be required. All Intellectual Property Rights generated under this program will solely belong to Tata Technologies.
- 5. The training may require tests to be conducted on a regular intervals during the entire course of DRE to evaluate the students' performance and based on the results, necessary guidance will be given to the students by the BEC Professors (who have undergone the 'DRE Train the Professors Workshop') so as to schieve a satisfactory status.
- BEC commits to make available the students, professors, training rooms and licensed CATIA V5 software on work stations during the course of the of the DRE program as may be required. This is necessary for a successful implementation and completion of the DRE program.
- Tata Technologies may charge some nominal fees for the training as agreed between the Parties. The nominal fee obtained from through this course will be utilised for corporate sustainability programs.
- a. Tata Technologies may hire the trained students and will have the 1 right of refusal for selection after these students complete their graduation which would meen that Tata Technologies may be the first company to interview these Students.
- 9. Proprietary information disclosed by Tata Technologies in the course of discussions and training under this MOU shall be kept highly confidential. BEC shall not use Tata Technologies' name or its trademarks or make any reference to the MOU or the DRE program in any manner of publicity without Tata Technologies' prior written consent.
- 10. Parties are aware that the business activities of Tata Technologies are self-regulated by the "Tata Code of Conduct" which is incorporated by reference herein. It can be accessed and downloaded from http://www.tatatechnologies.com.
- This MOU is effective from the date of signing and will remain valid unless terminated by either Party, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other Party.
- 12. This MOU shall be construed, and the legal relations between the Parties hereto shall be determined, in accordance with the substantive laws of India. The parties shall refer their disputes to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at Pune, India.
- 13. Neither this MOU nor any negotiations or other understandings prior or pursuant to the execution of the MOU shall constitute a binding and legally enforceable MOU, nor give rise to any liability, between the Parties.
