Subject: Important extracts of minutes of 13th meeting of Academic Council

Reference: DBATU/REG/MP/3358, dated October 23, 2019

With reference to the subject cited above, following are some of the important decision taken by the Academic Council of the University related to B.Tech & Diploma programs of the University.

1. Replacement of Relative Grading with Absolute Grading

Following absolute grading will replace relative grading system as given below, from Academic Year 2019-20 for all the students of I, II, III and IV year B.Tech, M. Tech etc.

The Class will be awarded based on the CGPA for eight semesters of B.Tech. Program for

$5.0 \leq \text{CGPA} < 5.50$ Pass Class

$5.5 \leq \text{CGPA} < 6.00$ Second Class

$6.0 \leq \text{CGPA} < 7.50$ First Class

$\text{CGPA} \geq 7.50$ Distinction

CGPA will be converted into percentage of marks by multiplying CGPA with a factor of 10.0.

CGPA: Cumulative Grade Point Average based on all Eight Semesters.

The above changes in Grading and award of Class will be implemented from the Academic Year 2019-20.

2. Minimum passing marks at the B.Tech End-Semester Examinations - Carrying 60% marks

Every student of B.Tech should get a minimum of 20 marks out of 60 marks from End-Semester Examination, to clear the course. This becomes effective from First Year B. Tech of the academic year 2019-20 onwards.

3. Minimum credits for "Carry On" – Promotion to Next Year:

Following Promotion Rules become, effective from the current academic year of 2019-20, for all the students of B.Tech I, II, III & IV year.

A) For students admitted directly:

1. Students should clear 60% of the total credits prescribed for First Year B.Tech program for claiming promotion to second year,
2. For claiming promotion to Third year, every student should clear 80% of the total credits of I and II Year B.Tech considered together.
3. For claiming promotion to Fourth year, every student should clear 86% of total credits of I, II and III Year B.Tech considered together.

B) For students admitted Laterally:

1. Students should clear 60% of the total credits prescribed for Second Year B.Tech program for claiming promotion to III year.
2. Students should clear 80% of the total credits prescribed for II & III year B.Tech program considered together for claiming promotion to IV year.

Following Promotion Rules become effective from the current academic year of 2019-20, for all the Diploma students:

(A) For students admitted Directly:

1. Students should clear 60% of the total credits prescribed for First Year Diploma program for claiming promotion to second year.

2. For claiming promotion to Third year, every student should clear 80% of the total credits of I and II Year considered together.

(B) For students admitted Latterly:

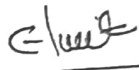
Students should clear 60% of the total credits prescribed for II Year program for claiming promotion to III year.

3. Alternative Arrangement for Mid-Semester and End-Semester Examinations for the students participating & representing the University in NCC, NSS or Sports at Inter- University, National Or International Level competitions:

Alternative Mid-Semester and End-Semester Examinations will be conducted for the Students representing the University in NCC, NSS or Sports at Inter-University, National Or International Level competitions, in case the dates of such competitions coincide with the dates of said examinations. The student needs to produce certificate duly certified by competent authority to the Controller of Examinations to avail this facility.
